- Other certificates with approval by academic panel of UMS Link Education Sector; and
- Candidate must be at least 21 years of age.

### Assessment

Upon completion of each module, students would undergo a quiz and submission of a project paper and examination.

### Program Fees

- Registration Fee: RM 200.00
- Course Fee : RM 9,000.00

### Training Methodology

Discussions, role plays, case studies, field studies, practices sessions, lectures and demonstrations. All practical work, which includes assignments, will require participants to use their workplace knowledge and skills.
