SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS

The School of Business Economics was established in 1995 with the objectives of producing managers and entrepreneurs in various fields of business to help Malaysia achieve the status of an industrial nation.

Currently, the school offers ten areas of study in the field of business and economics at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. There are more than 1,600 undergraduate and postgraduate students enrolled in various courses offered by the school.

a) Master of Business Administration (MBA)

The MBA programme is designed to prepare individuals with the latest management techniques, theories and practices to enable them to be more competitive in the global market. The programme will equip in the public as well as the private sectors.

Admission Requirements

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- A good Bachelor's degree with honours recognised by the University senate, or its equivalent qualification.
- Minimum of 1 year working experience (applicable to part-time candidates only).
- Good command of the English Language. **Overseas applicants are required** to furnish English test result such as TOEFL, IELTS or MUET.
- Successfully attended an interview, when required by the University.
- Required to show proof of competency in the English Language with the English Test Certificate such as **TOEFL, IELTS** or **UMSISFP**. Minimum score for TOEFL (550/213), IELTS (Band 6). However this requirement is waived for applicants from countries using English as a medium instruction. (International Student)

Candidates must successfully complete 40 credit hours to fulfil the MBA requirements as well as to defend their research projects at the end of the programme in order to be conferred the degree.

- ✓ Developing the capability of managers to integrate HR technology and psychological aspects of HCM.
- ✓ Promoting and developing responsible managers who will lead their organizations toward the creation of an excellent working environment.
- ✓ Enhancing knowledge and confidence levels among managers in various aspects (legal, managerial, technological, etc.) of HCM who will strengthen the efficiency of HCM in their respective organizations.
- ✓ Enhancing the HCM skills of managers that would allow them to gain recognition both locally and internationally.

Admission Requirements

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- A good Bachelor degree with honours in Human Capital Resource Management (HRM) / Business Administration or from any other disciplines recognized by the University Senate.
- Minimum of two (2) years working experience (applicable to part-time candidates only).
- Good command of the English language. **Overseas applicants are required** to furnish English test result such as TOEFL, IELTS or MUET.
- Successfully attended an interview, when required by the University.
- Required to show proof of competency in the English Language with the English Test Certificate such as **TOEFL, IELTS** or **UMSISFP**. Minimum score for TOEFL (550/213), IELTS (Band 6). However this requirement is waived for applicants from countries using English as a medium of instruction.
